

### **STARS Online Registration:**

You must access STARS V2 via a SAFE account and may obtain a SAFE account by visiting <http://education.ohio.gov/> and selecting SAFE Account Sign IN, and follow the prompts. Detailed instructions are at <http://www.sst9.org/STARS.html>. Once you have established a SAFE Account and are signed in (must update your User Profile in order to receive training notifications and email registration confirmation); click on Event Search.

- Review the events by date (01/09/2018 and 01/17/2018)
- Use the keywords "Alternate Assessment"
- Using the drop down arrow, select Region 9 State Support Team in the Event Sponsor/Owner box.
- Once the search results appear, click on "Event Starts" twice to sort the events chronologically.
- Click on the event and click "Register for Selected Event" button.
- Follow the remaining prompts until you can print your confirmation page with your name.
