Description:

This Ohio Longitudinal Transition Study (OLTS) workshop is designed for secondary personnel in Holmes, Stark and Wayne Counties who support students with disabilities. Dr. McMahan-Queen and Ms. Kaschak will present the latest research findings of the OLTS. The following topics will be addressed:

- What do the OLTS results say about Ohio and postsecondary outcomes for students?
- What does the OLTS data mean for students in our region?
- How can the data be used to improve services and outcomes for students?

Training will be provided for districts participating in the Indicator-14 required OLTS Initial Surveys and Follow-Up Interviews this Spring. Deadline to register is March 1, 2018.
