



In an effort to help combat the opioid epidemic, Ohio MHAS is once again sponsoring statewide training in PAX Good Behavior Game. PAX GBG is a classroom-based preventive intervention that gives teachers the skills and strategies to create nurturing environments in their classrooms by teaching self-regulation, co-regulation, and group regulation throughout their daily instruction. PAX GBG teaches students skills in delayed gratification that have shown in multiple controlled trials to dramatically improve behavioral, academic, and lifetime outcomes.

FREE Training Opportunity for Previously Trained PAX Teachers

Applications Accepted October 1-31, 2018 on the PAX Ohio Website (paxohio.org)

During the application process, Ohio teachers will select their first, second and third choice training dates/locations from a list of 32 regional training opportunities. All applicants will be notified of training placement by Nov. 7, 2018. To be eligible, teachers must have already attended an Initial PAX GBG Training within the past 2 years (*after August, 2016*).

PAX Heroes Teacher Training:

(For Previously Trained PAX Teachers Only)

PAX Heroes Certification provides PAX teachers with additional strategies to scaffold Universal Intervention (Tier 1) PAX Kernels and Cues for children who continue to struggle to be successful in the classroom, including Tier 2 and Tier 3 enhancements for children who exhibit challenging behaviors and under-developed self-regulation skills. ***(6-Hour Training)***.
